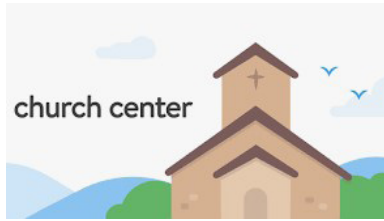

Welcome to Oakwood Church Center!

Check-ins on Sunday Morning:
