THE BLESSINGS OF REDEMPTION

Westminster Shorter Catechism, Questions 70-75

Q. 70. What is the seventh commandment?

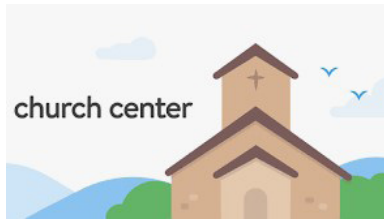

Welcome to Oakwood Church Center!

Check-ins on Sunday Morning:

You will check in your child(ren) once on Sunday morning for both Stepping Stones and Sunday School. This means you will use the same pick-up sticker for both pickups, so make sure you don't misplace it (or give it to the teacher).
