## WORSHIP SERVICE CHANGES

As was explained in [Pastor Dan's letter](#) for this week, the Session has decided to require everyone who comes to our worship services to wear a mask for the entire time that they are in our church building (except when partaking of communion). If you need a mask one will be provided at the door. Exceptions will be made for those who can't wear a mask for health reasons, those who can't remove a mask without assistance; those who need to communicate with someone who is hearing-impaired; and children under the age of 2 years.

**There will be only one worship service at 10:00 am this Sunday and on Sunday, July 19.** Beginning July 26, we will have a service at 8:30 am with extra precautions for those with health concerns (such as no singing) and another service with the procedures and order of service we've been using so far this summer at 11:15 am. Masks will be required at both services.
