### CONFESSION OF FAITH -

#### WESTMINSTER SHORTER CATECHISM, QUESTIONS 92,93,96,97

Q. 92. What is a sacrament?

**A. A sacrament is a holy ordinance instituted by Christ in which, by perceivable signs, Christ and the benefits of the New Covenant are represented, sealed, and applied to believers.**

Q. 93. Which are the sacraments of the New Testament?

**A. The sacraments of the New Testament are baptism and the Lord's supper.**

Q. 96. What is the Lord's supper?

**A. The Lord's supper is a sacrament in which, by giving and receiving of bread and wine according to Christ's command, His death is shown forth. Worthy receivers are made partakers of His body and blood by faith, not in a bodily or physical manner, to their spiritual nourishment and growth in grace, with all His benefits.**

Q. 97. What is required for receiving the Lord's supper in a worthy manner?

**A. Those who would partake of the Lord's supper in a worthy manner are required to examine themselves to be aware of their knowledge to discern the Lord's body, of their faith to feed on Him, and of their repentance, love, and new obedience. They do this so that they do not eat and drink judgment to themselves by coming unworthily.**
