Check-ins on Sunday Morning:

We received some great feedback on the first week of using our new *Check-Ins* software. We are making one critical change to help streamline the process: you will only need to check in your child(ren) once on Sunday morning for both Stepping Stones and Sunday School. This means you will use the same pick-up sticker for both pickups, so make sure you don't misplace it (or give it to the teacher). Note: teachers will still need to verify your pickup code, but keep the pickup sticker and leave your child's sticker on!

Check-ins for Nursery during the Service:

Parents must still check in nursery-age children in the Nursery when they are dropped off during the service.
