Check-ins on Sunday Morning:

We received some great feedback on our new *Check-Ins* software. We are making one change to help streamline the process, so you will only need to check in your child(ren) once on Sunday morning for both Stepping Stones and Sunday School. This means you will use the same pick-up sticker for both pickups, so make sure you don't misplace it (or give it to the teacher). Note: teachers will still need to verify your pickup code, but keep the pickup sticker and leave your child's sticker on!

Check-ins for Nursery during the Service:

Parents must still check in nursery-age children in the Nursery when they are dropped off during the service.
