# A Vision of Victory



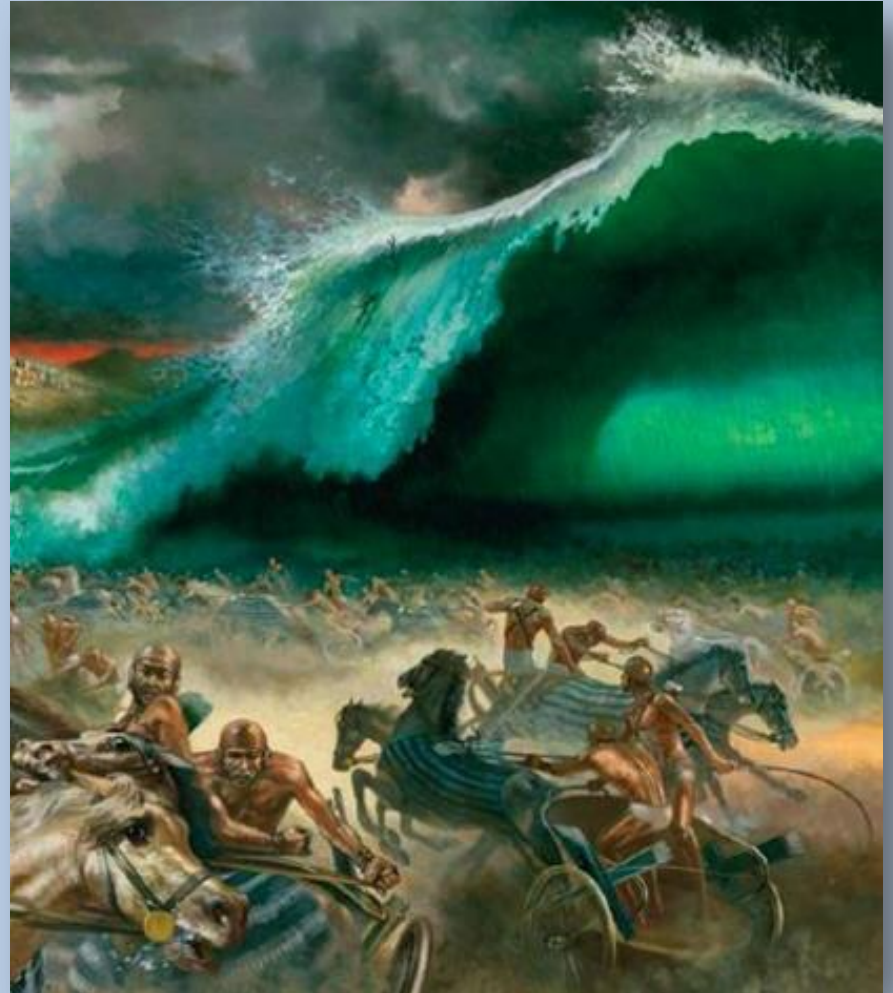

# The Song of Moses and of the Lamb

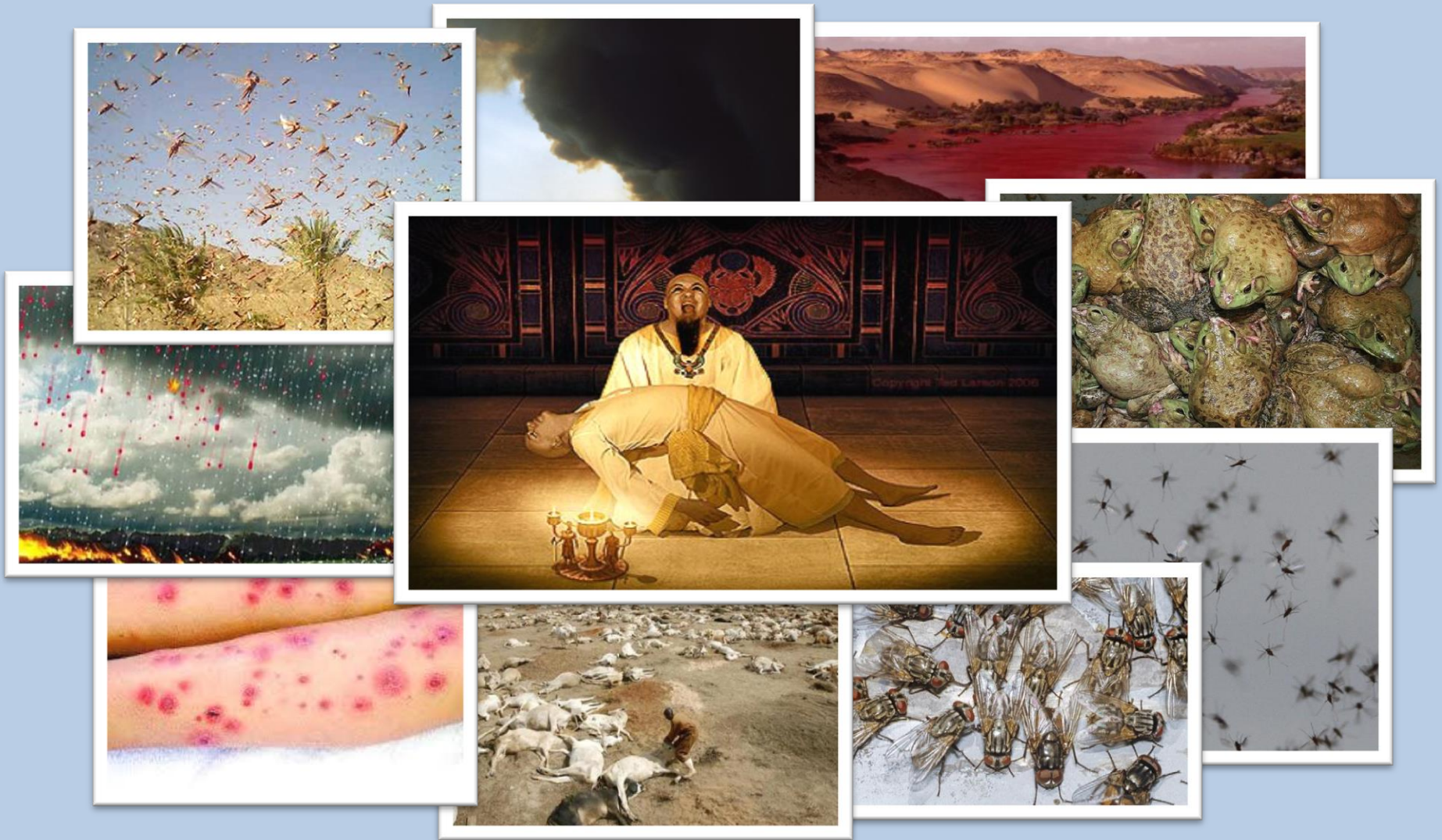

“...seven plagues, which are the last, for with them **the wrath of God is finished.**” Revelation 15:1b

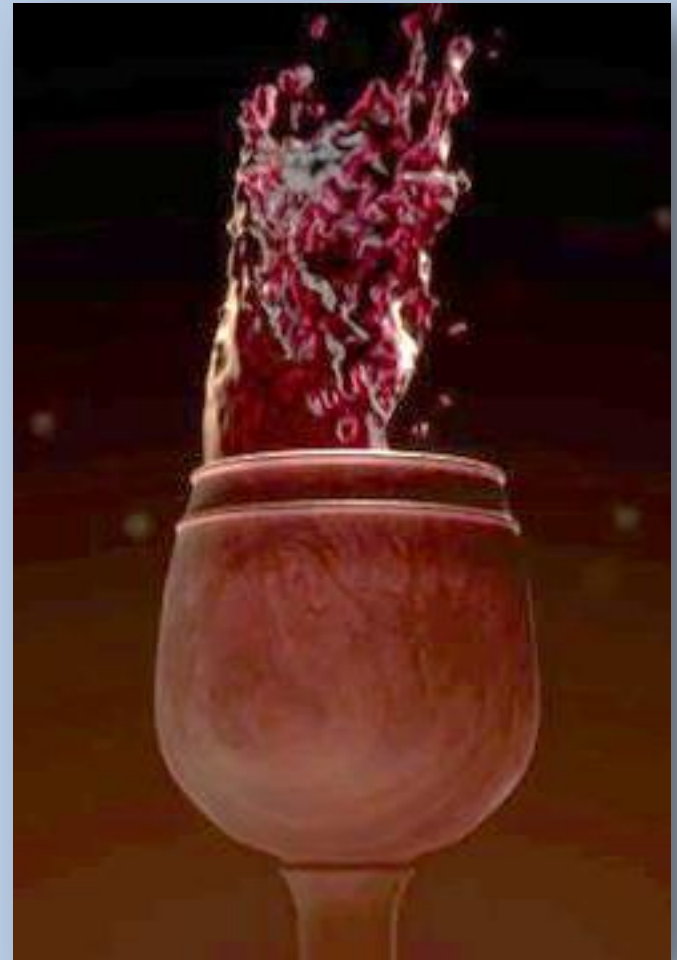
# Filling Up the Cup of God's Wrath

# Review – Trumpets – Chapter 8

**1<sup>st</sup> Trumpet** – hail, fire, blood  
- 1/3 of *earth*, trees, and  
grass burned

**2<sup>nd</sup> Trumpet** – burning mountain  
- 1/3 of *seas* become blood

**3<sup>rd</sup> Trumpet** – falling star  
- 1/3 of *fresh waters* poisoned

**4<sup>th</sup> Trumpet** – darkness  
- 1/3 of *sun, moon, and  
stars* darkened



**5<sup>th</sup> Trumpet** – locust army from hell  
- 5 months of torment, no killing



**6<sup>th</sup> Trumpet** – mounted troops released from across the Euphrates  
- 1/3 of mankind killed



**7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet** – lightning, thunder, earthquake, hail  
- final judgment

“The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, **did not repent...**” Revelation 9:20





# The 1<sup>st</sup> Bowl of Wrath – The Earth

”So the first angel went and poured out his bowl **on the earth**, and harmful and painful **sores** came upon the people who bore the mark of the beast and worshiped its image.”

# The 2<sup>nd</sup> Bowl of Wrath – The Sea



“The second angel poured out his bowl **into the sea**, and it became like the **blood** of a corpse, and every living thing died that was in the sea.”

Revelation 16:3

# The 3<sup>rd</sup> Bowl of Wrath – Rivers & Springs



“The third angel poured out his bowl **into the rivers** and the **springs of water**, and they became **blood.**”

Revelation 16:4



# Answer to the Cry of the Martyrs

“I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the witness they had borne. Revelation 6:9-11

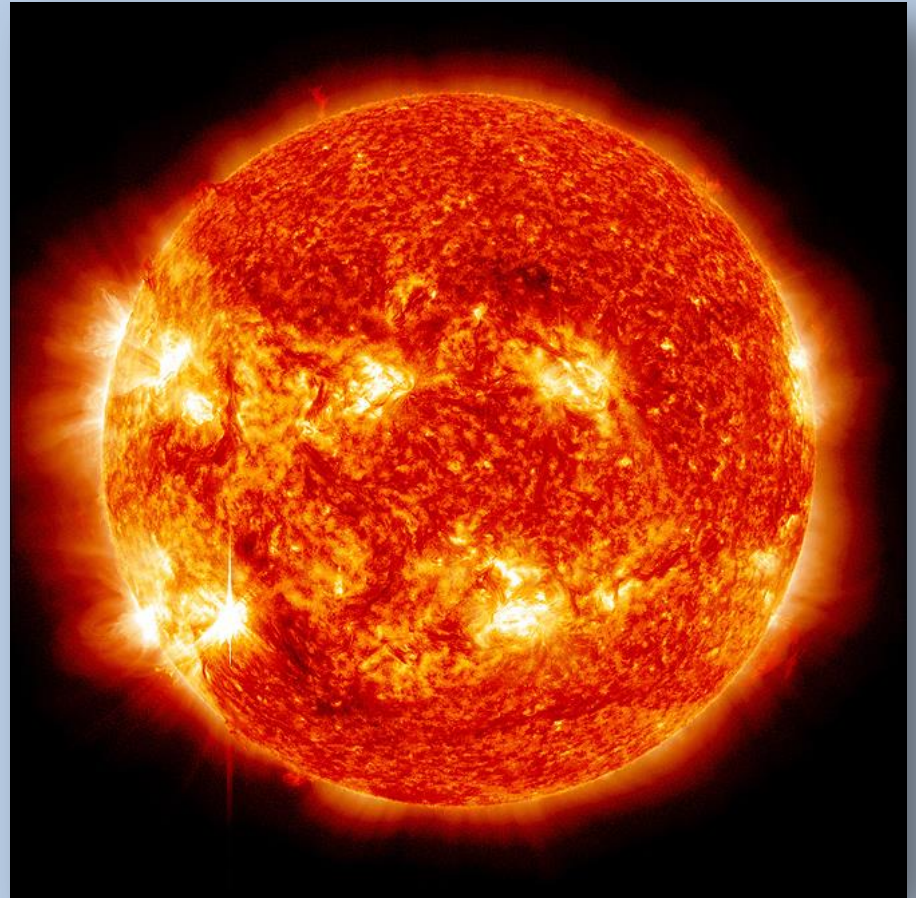

# The 4<sup>th</sup> Bowl of Wrath – The Sun

Revelation 16:10,11

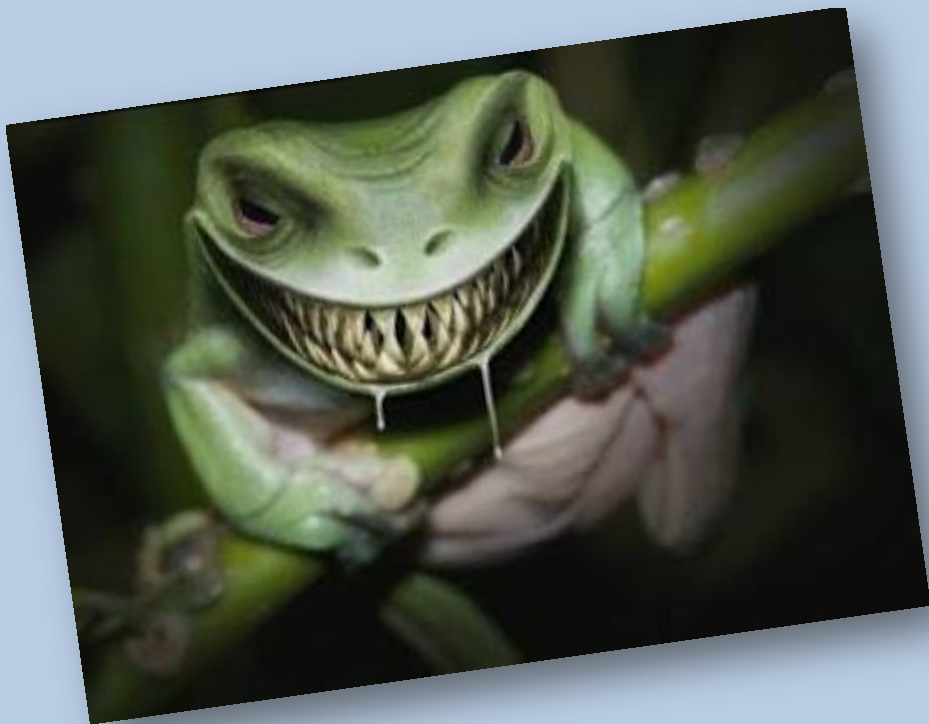


# The 6<sup>th</sup> Bowl of Wrath – The Euphrates

# The 3 Unclean Spirits and Armageddon

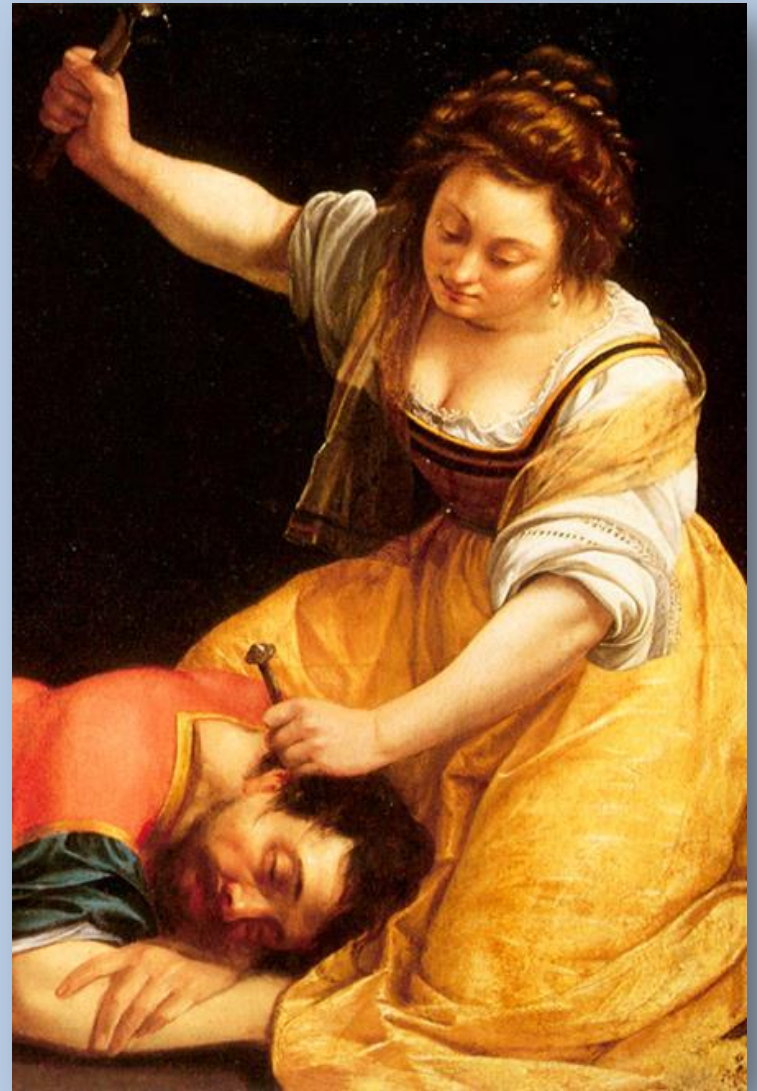


“And I saw, coming out of the mouth of the **dragon** and out of the mouth of the **beast** and out of the mouth of the **false prophet**, three **unclean spirits like frogs**. For they are demonic spirits, performing signs, who go abroad to the **kings** of the whole world, **to assemble them for battle** on the great day of God the Almighty... And they assembled them at the place that in Hebrew is called **Armageddon.**”

Revelation 16:13-16

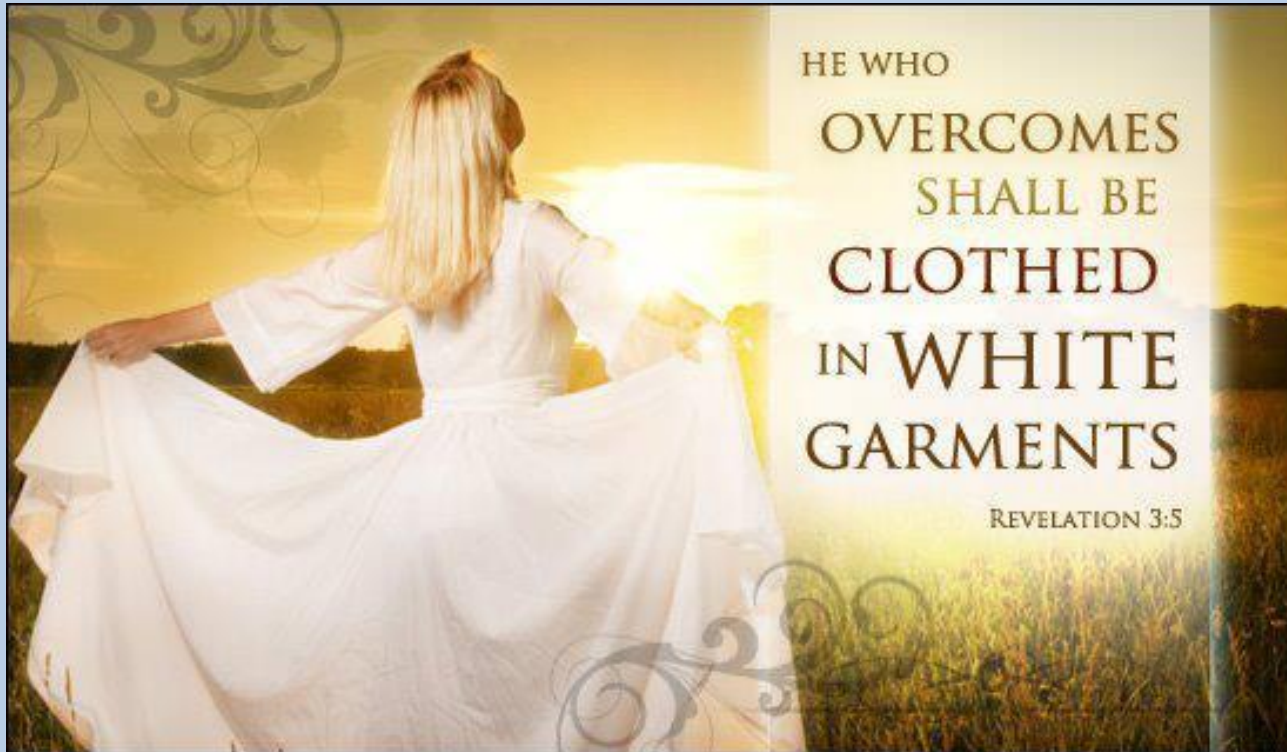
“And the people of Israel again did what was evil in the sight of the LORD... And the LORD sold them into the hand of Jabin king of Canaan... The commander of his army was Sisera... Then the people of Israel cried out to the LORD for help, for he had 900 chariots of iron and he oppressed the people of Israel cruelly for twenty years... And Deborah said to Barak, **‘Up! For this is the day in which the LORD has given Sisera into your hand. Does not the LORD go out before you?’** So Barak went down from Mount Tabor with 10,000 men following him. And the LORD routed Sisera and all his chariots and all his army before Barak by the edge of the sword... The kings came, they fought; then fought the kings of Canaan... **by the waters of Megiddo;** they got no spoils of silver. From heaven the stars fought, from their courses they fought against Sisera.”

# The Cup of Salvation

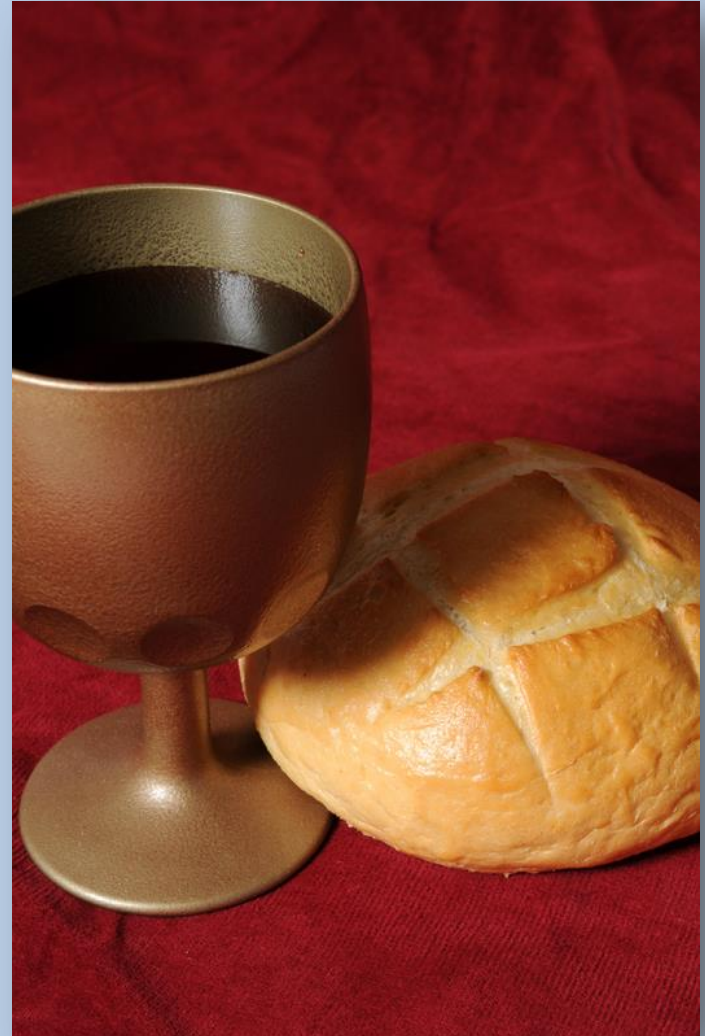
“Jesus said to them, ‘You do not know what you are asking. **Are you able to drink the cup that I drink...?**’”

And every island fled away, and no mountains were to be found.
